Maths: Revision of all prior learning

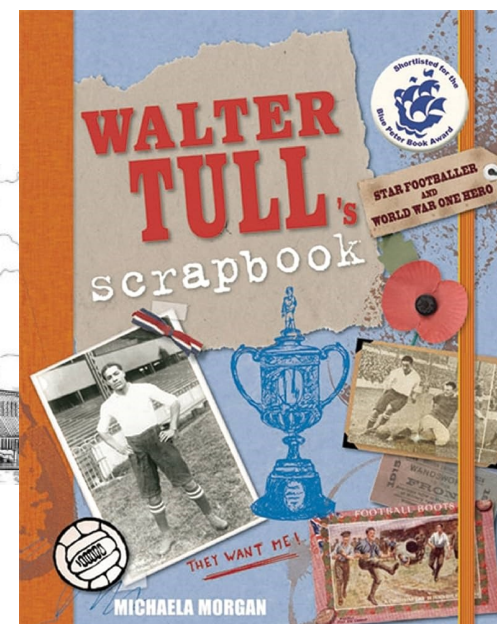
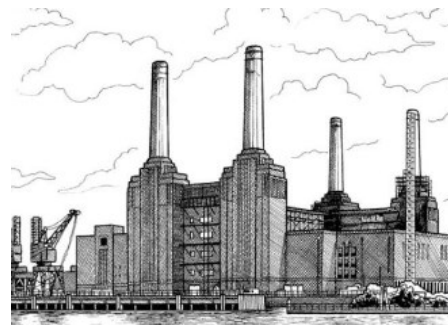
Science: Animals Including Humans: The Circulatory System
