

Curriculum Overview for Year 1 - Summer 2

Our theme for this term is 'Seaside'

Here is a list of what your child will be learning this half term:

English core book: The Secret of Black Rock, Billy's Bucket, Surprising Sharks

Maths: Counting in different ways (2s, 5s and 10s), value of money and time.

Science: Seasons and the changes which occur through the year.

History: Would you rather go to the seaside now or in the past? Comparing the seaside now and then.

RE: Moral Stories - Is there anything we can learn from stories?

Art: Collage- materials to make a seaside collage inspired by Eileen Agar and Henri Matisse

Music: Duration and tonality - Exploring the duration of notes and beginning to notate these.

PE: Athletics - running, jumping and sprinting in preparation for sports day.

Computing: Digital literacy - Recording videos as TV chefs.

PSHCE lessons will focus on emotional wellbeing and will be a space to discuss global/local/school issues as they arise.
