Have a wonderful weekend and we are looking forward to seeing you on Sunday for Run Chesterton Run.

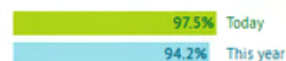

Classroom Corner 1M

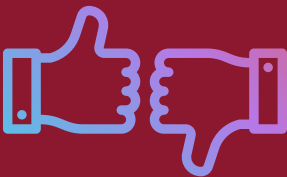

We offer Breakfast Club and After School Care for Reception to Year 6. Nursery children can join when settled, as discussed with their teacher and agreed with our senior leadership team.



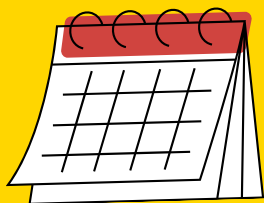

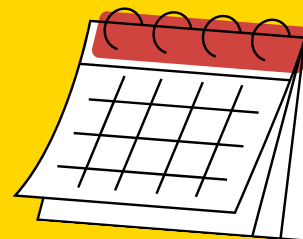


Need a Helping Hand?

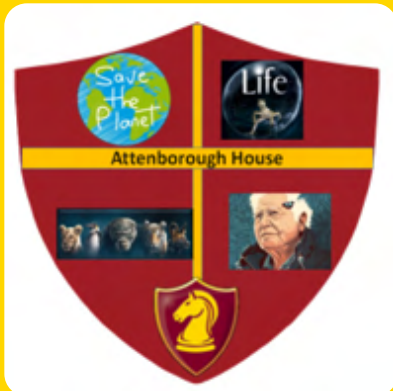

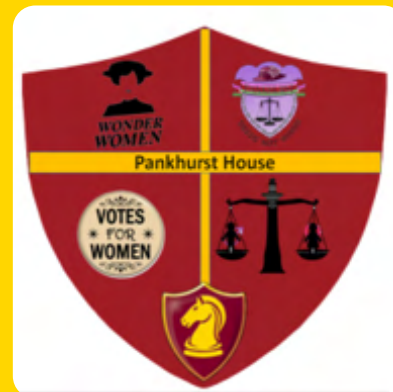
