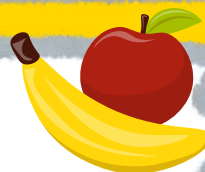


Donations of trainers and football boots

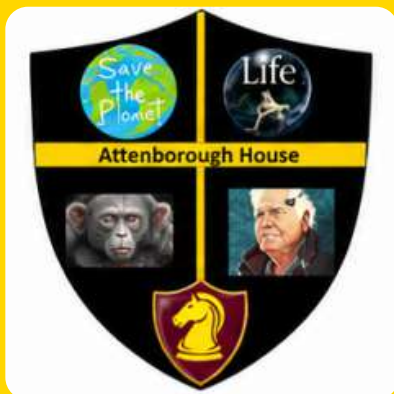

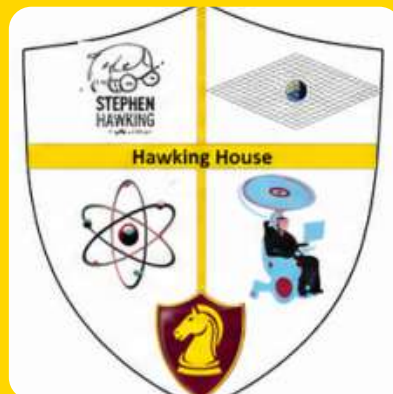

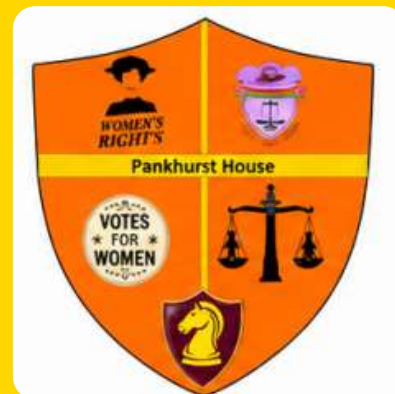
