Personal, Social and Emotional Development: Sharing and self care.

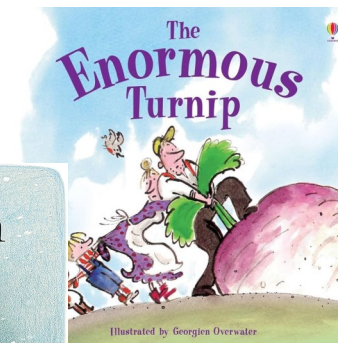
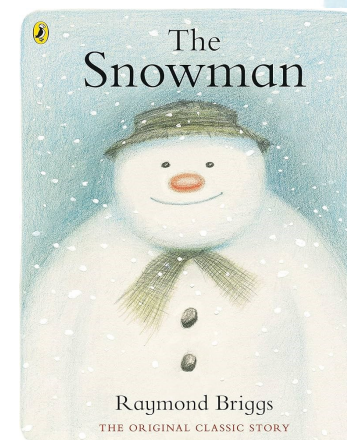
Communication and Language: Using short phrases and sentences clearly.
