What is it?

- All children are learning the Young Voices songs as part of their music curriculum, looking at enhancing their performance skills.
- Your child then has the opportunity to perform these songs with the world's largest choir at the O2!





The Day

- This is a long day! It will be so rewarding but it is tough!
- The children will have early lunch at school before catching public transport (a mainline train and a tube) to the venue.
- The children then rehearse with the other schools. This includes testing bright stage lighting and running through their entire repertoire.
- The children will then have a dinner break. They will need to have this with them.
- Finally they will perform, with the concert ending at 8:45pm.
- The children will then return together to school. Pick up will be from school at approximately 10:30pm.



What to bring

- Packed dinner (your child will have lunch as usual at school. If they eat a packed lunch they will need both. We recommend these are packed separately)
- A white t-shirt. These do not have to be Young Voices branded.
- A water bottle.
- Comfortable shoes as there is lots of standing!
