Emergency Issues (medicines/phone numbers etc)

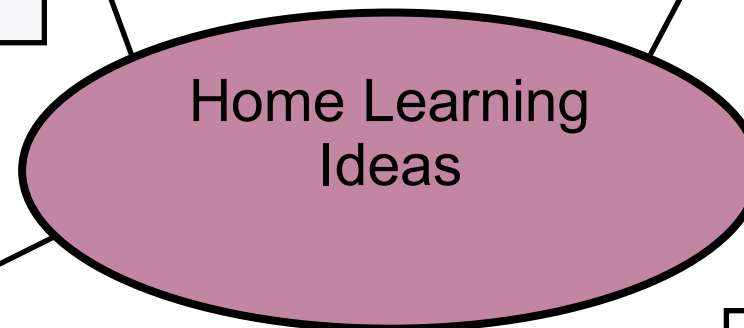

History

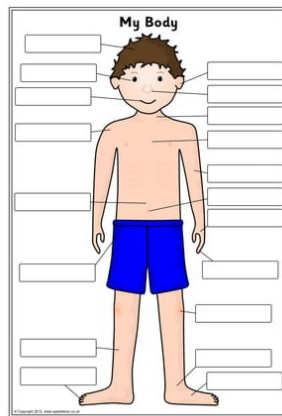
- Create a timeline of Queen Elizabeth II. Include her birth, coronation, platinum jubilee and her death.



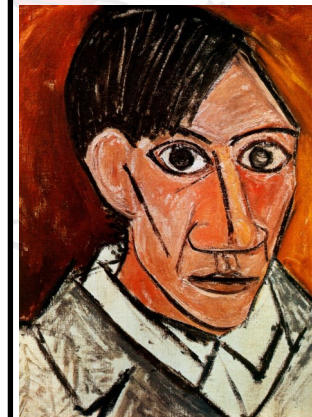
- Create a poster explaining what happens in a coronation. Remember to include key people like the Archbishop of Canterbury.
